

Emergency Rental Assistance Available in Groton



In response to the loss of income to Groton households due to the coronavirus (COVID-19), the Town of Groton has created the Emergency Rental Assistance Program utilizing Community Preservation Act funds.

Applicants are eligible for:

- Up to eight months of assistance (with extension after initial four months)
- Maximum monthly payment: \$800 1BR; \$1,000 2BR; \$1200 3BR.

Eligible Households:

• Total Household income (at the time of application) cannot exceed the following limits:

Household size	1 person	2 person	3 person	4 person	5 person	6 person
