279 Main St. Mr. Boles made a motion to take action on this abatement after Town Meeting on June 13, 2011. If the property is purchased by the town the abatement will be granted to a 0 tax bill. Should the town vote not to purchase the property the board will abate the value to the offered sales price of \$450,000 for FY 2011. Seconded by Ms. Evans, all in favor.

760 and 768 Boston Rd. the board reviewed all the income and expense data submitted by the lawyer in support of the value requested on the abatement application. The boards reviewed all the calculations in Vision as well as do an analysis of the market data. The board is willing to make a counter offer to abate if the case is withdrawn from the ATB.
