# MEETING MINUTES July 21, 2014

Meeting Called to Order:

Chairman Weber called the meeting to order at 7:03 pm in the Town Hall.

## 945 Townsend Road

Mr. Grossman provided the Board with an update on this property, adding that he had not been contacted by the homeowner to arrange a time to conduct water sampling. Also, no one had contacted him regarding the trash. Mr. Grossman said he would check back in October.

### Raw Milk

Regarding the upcoming variance request, the Board asked if research could be done on how other towns have handled similar requests.

# Maplewood Avenue – Kevin Hibbert

Mr. Hibbert was before the board seeking guidance on his septic system upgrade. He said the installer made a "field change" and now the system was in (the ground) but could not be signed off on.

Mr. Grossman said the groundwater offset was now 4.5 feet instead of the 5 feet as approved, and that there were now 2 options:

- Attempt another test hole (to provide more favorable data, risky)
- Go with a pump system rather than a pressure dosed system

# 43 Boston Road

Member Horowitz made a motion to accept the signed agreement between the Board of Health and Vincent Atwood, owner of the above mentioned address for a waiver to a sewer tie-in. Member Fleischer seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Member Fleischer made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:54PM. Member Horowitz seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.
