MEETING MINUTES August 17, 2015

Meeting Called to Order:

Chairman Fleischer called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm in the Town Hall.

Travis Beaver

Mr. Grossman recommended to the Board that Mr. Beaver be served a one-year suspension from being able to install septic systems in the Town of Groton. Member Horowitz supported the suspension decision and stated that if he would like to install systems in Town, Mr. Beaver would need to come before the Board to ask for permission to do so.

Member Weber requested the letter also be sent to the owner of the company (A. Francis Construction) for which Mr. Beaver subcontracts.

Member Horowitz made a motion to suspend Mr. Travis Beaver from installing systems in Town for one year (August 2015-August 2016). Member Weber seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Johnsons Dairy Bar inspection report

Mr. Grossman stated the last couple of inspection reports have contained critical violations that need to be addressed. He said he feels the establishment may lack management or follow through on day-to-day operations, possibly due to the young staff. He suggested a meeting with the owner.

Member Horowitz made a motion to meet on August 31, 2015 at 6:15PM with the owner to discuss these issues further. Member Weber seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

CHP 190 – Michael Weinberg

DISCLOSURE: Mr. Weinberg is an acquaintance of Chairman Fleischer and a client of Member Horowitz.

Mr. Grossman stated Mr. Weinberg needs to do a Title 5 and is requesting more time in addition to the time he was already granted by the Board in order to connect. Mr. Grossman recommends against giving additional time, and stated this would have to be moved through the court process.

Member Horowitz made a motion to require Mr. Weinberg to provide a Title 5 within 30 Days. If not it will begin to move through the court process. Member Weber seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Mr. Grossman gave the Board an update on the previous noise complaint. He stated this is now a police matter as it was discovered children were involved.

Member Weber made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:09PM. Member Horowitz seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.
