The Commission reviewed the plans of the Union Congregational Church addition at the rear of the building. Attorney Robert Collins and design engineer Frank McPartlan presented the plan.

Mr. McPartlan submitted an updated plan showing the drop-off area on Willowdale Road and signage for the accessible parking spaces. The new curb cut will include a tactile warning square.

Member Tom Pistorino suggested that the curbing along Willowdale Road be painted yellow for better visibility. ADA Coordinator Michelle Collette said painting the curbing on a public street would require approval of the DPW Director.

The motion was made by Tom Pistorino, seconded by Judy Anderson, to support the Union Congregation Church plans, prepared by Dillis and Roy, dated November 7, 2023, and revised on July 1, 2024, with the condition that all signage must comply with 521 CMR Architectural Access Board Regulations. The motion passed unanimously.

The training will be held on the second or fourth Thursday of the month sometime in the fall at the Senior Center.
