Discuss (possible vote) on changes to the current Lecture Fund policy of paying for items other than speaker/presentation fee. This could include but not limited to venues, advertising, materials, administrative fees, etc.

Martha would like to consider a couple of new additions to what the Lecture Fund covers, such as, admin fee and advertising. The question was asked, What is an admin fee?. Answer was the salary for the person at the organization to register classes. Should the Lecture Fund "support" groups? Advertising might help to bring more people to the event. What is the cost for advertising? Social media (FB, website, etc.) does not charge. Commissioners would like more information on the break down of an admin fee.
