Project Description

Introduction

Groton Dunstable Youth Softball League (GDYSL) provides an educational, developmental softball league for youths ages 4 to 16 years old. The league focuses on development of skill and character, self- confidence, sportsmanship, and teamwork, including commitment to the team and preparation for future play. League rules are designed to give as much playing time as possible to all players, and competition is varied by level.

GDYSL is 100% funded through registration fees, donations, sponsors, and limited fundraising activities. The entire organization is run by unpaid volunteers including our 7-member Board of Directors, Division Coordinators, and coaches who all work to ensure the league runs smoothly. Our volunteers include members knowledgeable and trained to perform light field maintenance such as infield grooming and lining. In 2025, our volunteers committed over 200 hours of service to maintaining our current playing fields.

The players, members, and leaders of GDYSL are serious about providing a long-term home for enjoyable, safe recreational youth softball in the Town of Groton. With your support, we look forward to welcoming with pride visiting players to the GDYSL home field at the Cutler Memorial Field complex.

In FY24, a CPC funded project was approved to complete the construction of two new softball fields at Cutler. The funding provided for the installation of the two playing surfaces and for two backstops, which was completed in May 2025. Full use of these fields by youth softball cannot be realized until some critical additions are made to the complex. These additions will ensure safety of the playing fields, ongoing maintenance of the fields by the GDYSL volunteers, and meet the standards of appropriate playing fields by our governing body, USA Softball. The following proposal has been greatly reduced in scope from our Preliminary Application, reflecting the highest needs for safety and field use.

Project Details and Costs

1. Outfield clearing for Field 1

The left field side of Field #1 (closest to the parking lot) is short and does not meet the regulation size for softball fields. GDYSL would like to remove the brush and some trees to push the field to 200' from home plate. This will also require some earth removal and grading so that the outfield will be flat. We expect that this work can be done with the support of Groton DPW and work of our volunteers and does not require additional CPC funding at this time.

2. Installation of bases

The base anchors that were installed for the FY24 project were not done correctly and do anchors and will commit \$4500 in professional labor to properly install the base anchors. not meet proper safety standards. GDYSL has purchased \$1000 for new bases and


