

GROTON CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Minutes

March 29, 2004

Craig Auman called the meeting to order at 6:35 p.m. in the second floor lunch room at the Town Hall. Kris Corwin, Peter Morrison, Bruce Easom, Stacey Laudenslager, and Bruce Clements were also present. Conservation Assistant Barbara Ganem was present.

P. Morrison stated that the warrant articles for the upcoming town meeting include an article for \$50,000 for the Conservation Fund with the promise from the Board of Selectmen that they will take a closer look in the fall. He indicated that it was his recommendation to accept this amount for now. It can be modified on town meeting floor. C. Auman commented that the Selectmen have twice failed to consider this fall request. Upon a motion by B. Clements, seconded by K. Corwin, it was

VOTED: to support the request of \$50,000 for the Conservation Fund with the further recommendation that the issue will be re-visited in the fall.

Chairman Auman said that Habitat for Humanity has approached him about using the Sargisson Beach parking lot for an open house they are holding on April 17th. Upon a motion by P. Morrison, seconded by K. Corwin, it was

VOTED: to authorize the use of the parking area at the Sargisson Conservation Area on April 17th for the Habitat for Humanity ground-breaking ceremony.

Upon a motion by P. Morrison, seconded by B. Clements and with a roll call vote of Kris Corwin, Peter Morrison, Bruce Easom, Stacey Laudenslager, Bruce Clements, and Craig Auman, it was

VOTED: to enter into Executive Session for the purpose of discussing pending litigation, not to re-convene in Open Session.

The regular meeting concluded at 6:40 p.m.
