Monday, July 19, 2004

Chairman Clements called the meeting to order at 7:35 p.m. Members Bruce Easom, Peter Morrison, Kris Corwin, Evan Owen, and Craig Auman were also present. Stacey Laudenslager was absent. Conservation Assistant Barbara Ganem was present.

B. Ganem reported that she has received two inquiries about groups using Sargisson Beach for outings. Upon a motion by P. Morrison, seconded by K. Corwin, it was

VOTED: that non-profit groups, such as Boy Scouts, could use the parking area for \$5/car while for-profit groups would be required to pay the full 1-day pass fee of \$10/car.

Members signed a Determination on which action was taken at the July 13, 2004 meeting.

Stacey Laudenslager has indicated that she will be resigning from the Commission due to the recent arrival of her baby. Members suggested that the opening be announced on the web, cable television, and in the newspaper.

VOTED: to enter Executive Session to discuss pending litigation, not to return to Open Session.
