

## GROTON CONSERVATION COMMISSION

### Minutes

June 19, 2010

Chairman Bruce Easom called the meeting to order at 8:030 a.m. in the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor conference room in Town Hall. Members Wayne Addy, Craig Auman, Marshall Giguere, Ryan Lambert, and David Pitkin were present. Neither member Peter Morrison nor Conservation Administrator Barbara Ganem was present.

Scout John O'Brien was present to see if the Commission would be willing to sign off on his Eagle Scout project prior to his 18<sup>th</sup> birthday. The original project was to put in 10 kestrel and 10 wood duck boxes, and these have been put in. There are several locations which may have too high traffic. Four wood duck boxes were installed at Burntmeadow, three at Herons Ridge, and three at Williams Barn Sorhaug Woods. Five kestrel boxes have gone in on Surrenden Farm, one at Groton Place, three at Bates-Blackman, and one at Angus Acre.

Chairman Easom looked at all the installed boxes on Tuesday, June 15<sup>th</sup>. Many of the wood duck boxes that were PVC pipe and concrete had fallen over. Mr. Easom read a letter of acknowledgement and appreciation dated 6/19/2010. M. Giguere made a motion, seconded by D. Pitkin, and it was

VOTED: to send the letter of acknowledgement and appreciation to John O'Brien for those boxes that were installed on Town-owned conservation land.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 8:12 a.m.
