

**EARTH REMOVAL STORMWATER ADVISORY COMMITTEE
SEPTEMBER 22, 2015
MINUTES**

Vice Chairman Hanninen called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM

RECOMMENDATION TO THE BOARD OF SELECTMEN – ELLIOT EARTH REMOVAL EXEMPTION

The Committee reviewed the application for an earth removal exemption submitted by David Elliot to remove 3000 cubic yards of contaminated soil at 36 Court Street, the site of the former May and Haley Oil Company. The material is being removed under the supervision of a Licensed Site Professional (LSP), pursuant to MGL Chapter 21E.

The motion was made by Hanninen, seconded by Swezey, to recommend that the Selectmen grant the earth removal exemption for removal of 3000 cubic yards of contaminated soil from 36 Court Street with the standard conditions and following special conditions:

1. The hours of operation should be at the discretion of the Police Chief.
2. The need for dust control is extremely important given the nature of the soils to be removed.
3. There shall be no tracking of sediments onto the public way.
4. A 50 ft construction entrance must be installed at the end of the asphalt access.
5. The project must be supervised by the LSP.
6. A safety fence must be installed along the Nashua River Rail Trail to prevent access to the site.
7. No trucks should use Court Street because it is a residential neighborhood.

The motion passed unanimously.
