

**EARTH REMOVAL STORMWATER ADVISORY COMMITTEE

MINUTES**

Vice Chairman Robert Hanninen called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM in the Town Hall.

PLAN REVISION – 788 BOSTON ROAD

The Committee received a request from GPR, Inc. to change the type of Tree Box filters in the stormwater management system for the 788 Boston Road commercial development site. The Committee also received a report dated September 5, 2017 from Nitsch Engineering.

The motion made by McHugh, seconded by Delaney, to approve the minor revision to the plan entitled, "Commercial Development, 788 Boston Road, Groton, Massachusetts," prepared by GPR, Inc., dated April 11, 2017, with revisions through May 31, 2017, to allow as an approved equivalent the TreePod Biofilter tree box rather than the Filterra Bioretention units provided on the approved plan set.

The Committee determined, after review and consultation with Nitsch Engineering, that the modifications to the stormwater management system appear to be relatively minor. The tree-box filters must be maintained in accordance with the "Long Term Pollution Prevention & Stormwater Management System Operation and Maintenance Plan," prepared by GPR, Inc.

The motion passed unanimously.

Stormwater Inspector Michelle Collette noted that construction at 788 Boston Road is very well managed.
