

**EARTH REMOVAL STORMWATER ADVISORY COMMITTEE
TUESDAY, AUGUST 22, 2022, 6:00 PM
MINUTES**

Chairman Savage called the virtual meeting to order at 6:00 PM.

Members present: Steven Savage, George Barringer, Bruce Easom, and Bob Hanninen

GROTON HILL MUSIC

The Committee met with Gary Shepherd of Groton Hill Music to discuss completion of the project so the facility could be open to the public in September 2022. The Committee asked what work had been done since the Nitsch field report dated August 1, 2022 and the Christopher Environmental Associates report dated August 10, 2022.

Mr. Shepherd said the access road and parking lots had been paved that day, and the intersection of Old Ayer Road and Main Street had been improved in accordance with the agreement with the Town. The runoff to James Brook is cleaner now that it was before the project began. All ADA and emergency vehicle access requirements have been met.

Chairman Savage asked how long it would take to complete the remaining site work. Mr. Shepherd said until the spring or summer of 2023. They are still working on the area in the rear of the building. Their goal is to meet all the Town's requirements.

The motion was made by Hanninen, seconded by Easom, to issue a partial Certificate of Completion for Groton Hill Music. The motion passed unanimously by roll call vote: Hanninen – aye, Easom-aye, Barringer – aye, Savage – aye.

Mr. Shepherd said they would be holding a “hard hat” concert on December 3, 2022 and all Committee members are welcome to attend.
