Baddacook Pond is listed as a Great Pond, so it is considered Commonwealth property. It is MassDEP's understanding that the Groton Water District does not own or control the entire 400' radius Zone 1 associated with the Baddacook Well because there are other landowners that own some of the land.

MPA is not required to be sampled on a routine basis. MassDEP can require MPA testing at any time. In addition to the sampling results I provided for 2005, 2006, and 2007, MPA sampling on the Baddacook Pond dug well was also done 10/7/92, and 4/6/93, both with Low results.
