 - Marion and David explained the goals and mission of the Groton Greenway Committee for Matt, including:

River Festival

Quality of the river a priority

Habitat for wildlife

Protect the flood plain and wetlands

Protect the trail system next to the river

200 miles are now protected.

III. DeCilio Property

Marion led a discussion of the DeCilio property:
 DeCilio's want to sell 14 acres, and Groton School is playing a part. Groton School will acquire 7 acres and another person in Groton will hold another 4-5 acres. Therefore, there will be a public entry from Rt. 225 to the property.

- Expand the riparian buffers along the Squanacook River.
- Al would like Groton Greenway support and asked for our help in identifying land along the Squanacook River that needs reforestation.
- One area is Hollingsworth and Vose area and also Deluxe Bertozzi area is eroded.

- V. Milkweed Planting Project
 - Marion and Alision met with Ben and Susan Black.
 - Alison offered to pay Ben Black to prepare the area for planting.
 - Ben will dig up 10 plots areas for \$300.
 - Alison will check with the sustainability commission to cover the cost; otherwise,
 Alison will cover it.
 - Cost of seed is \$195.
 - Alison asked if Groton Greenway could pay \$100.
 - Alison will need to submit cancelled check or credit card/bank statement.

VI. "Greenway Heroes" Film

 Marion reported that Groton Geenway may want to sponsor Susan Edwards' film, "Greenway Heroes", which was made to show in people's homes, to identify and encourage others to become Greenway Heroes.
