    - Canoe construction with an adult
    - Content of liability waiver/signed document
    - Do we need a specific form for Cardboard Canoe Event
    - Unsupervised kids wading without life jackets
    - Kids swimming
  - 2. Additional Issues/Facts
    - 78 people signed up for boat rides
    - Approximately 70 people took the rides
    - 14-16 boat rides were taken, and all ran smoothly.
    - Marina: There was room for more exhibits
    - Poster: Need more specific information: address of Deluxe parking should be on the poster as well as more specific location of the event (Intersection of Nod Road and Rte. 119).
      Free parking and shuttle from Deluxe to the event.
    - A welcome sign is needed at the entrance to the boat launch.
    - We need confirmation of exhibit groups ( such as Audubon)
    - Clarity of organization is needed for next year as well as comprehensive marketing.
    - Event should be listed in Action Unltd.

- We need more 30-60 lb. life jackets because there was a shortage this year.
- Marina is now the official marketing person.
