Pepperell IMA

No updates, just waiting on updated billing.

Seven Hills Group Home

Mr. Orcutt told the BOSC he received a letter from the Planning Board regarding an application for a new group home for disabled youths. Mr. Gmeiner suggested we invite the applicant in to discuss the sewer connection fees and see if there would be an increase.

Mr. Orcutt thought it would consist of knocking down one or two buildings and building one larger building with 12 beds, so that would increase occupancy. Mr. Gmeiner asked what the existing bed count was and Mr. Orcutt said 6-7 bedrooms. Mr. Gmeiner said that we should alert the Planning Board that Seven Hills needs to come before the sewer commission before they close the hearing.

Mr. Orcutt said this has been submitted to Town Counsel and they are reviewing. He said there may be some language changes and this could take a few weeks to hear back.

Mr. Orcutt said he has not, but he did meet with the engineers about water/sewer and relayed a message that the 8" line that is in deluxe would need to be completely replaced or at minimum camered to make sure there is no I&I leakage. Mr. Orcutt said they were looking for some invert elevations on Main Street and Mr. Gmeiner said any information given from As Builts always tell them "That what the plans say" and we advise you double check.

Mr. Gmeiner asked that we check with Select Board and see what was submitted to the State and he would like a copy.

Mr. Gmeiner asked if we got any certified numbers yet and Ms. Crory said "no".

Other Business: Bills, Minutes, etc.

Abatement - 8 Elm Street

Ms. Crory told the BOSC she received an abatement request for 8 Elm Street. The customer had a leaky toilet and the owner did have the plumber out to make the necessary repairs and submitted receipts. According to his average quarterly bills he was billed a total of 12-units extra.

Mr. Orcutt made a motion to abate 12 sewer units at 8 Elm Street at the lowest tier for a total of \$144.32 Mr. Bouchard seconded and the motion passed unanimously. Roll Call: Gmeiner-Aye, Orcutt-Aye and Bouchard-Aye

<u>Shaws - Billing</u>

Ms. Crory told the BOSC she just finished up the quarterly billing and it seems that Shaws has not resolved the issue. Mr. Gmeiner asked that we issue another letter to them regarding the evaporator cooling system and wait for their response. Mr. Orcutt was in agreement and said the other issue with this extra usage is that it could trip or IMA with Ayer.
