- 2. Review draft minutes of 8/21/01: approved, as written. Review draft minutes of 8/27/01: approved, with changes noted. Review draft minutes of 9/6/01: approved, with changes noted. Review draft minutes of 9/18/01: approved, as written. Review minutes of 10/16/01: approved, with changes noted. Johnson moved to provide agendas & approved minutes for posting to the Town's website. Seconded by L. Moore. Vote: unanimous.
- 3. Richard Zanbernardi, in attendence at tonight's meeting, requested the recording information (book & page) relative to any GHDC map, as referred to in the Town of Groton Code. D. Barton acknowledged the request, discussed his research at the Town Clerk's office & his conversation with Mr. Chris Skelley of the Mass Historical Commission & that he would pass the request along to the Selectmen's office.
- 4. Letter (copy of) from Barbara Scaffidio re: speed of traffic on Main St was received & noted.
- 5. S. Johnson provided the committee members with a copy of Caleb Butler's field notebook; thanks are due to Town Clerk, Bonnie Biocchi.
- 6. Sign lighting changes were noticed by a committee member at Century 21 on Hollis St. Upon discussion, members were unsure if actual changes were made or if the bulbs were replaced and a higher wattage was in use.
- 7. Also, the barn at The Elms was re-roofed and there is a new copper skylight. Committee members felt that the roof did not have a skylight previously and requested that D. Barton send the property owner a letter.
