- 7:35P Farmers Row campus: Groton School-Gardner House: PUBLIC HEARING cont'd to consider an application for a Certificate of Appropriateness for the demolition of the Gardner House situated behind Hundred House on the Groton School campus (Assessors Map 219-Parcel 9, Attorney Robert Collins presenting, votes may be taken. Open at 7:40P, DB recused, (2 other buildings will remain, Dome & barn) there are only 3 nice rooms, rest of rooms are very small, some interior components will be repurposed, RC & MG say they cannot support a full demo, continued to 1/19/16 @ 7:35P; DB returns.
- 8:00P <u>Historic Districts 1 & 2</u>: cont'd informal discussion requested by the Historic Commission regarding placing the districts on the National Register, votes may be taken. Trigger for interest was looking into getting the old meeting house on the Register, SJ will be the HDC point person for contact with HC Bob DeGroot, SJ motion to support efforts as presented, LM 2nd, vote: unanimous. MG recused.
- 8:10P <u>99 Main Street: TOG-Library</u>: application for a Certificate of Appropriateness for a driveup book return box / area in the library parking lot; Library Trustee presenting, votes may be taken. Mark, trustee present, no concerns with wall repairs as previously presented, if not repairable or if need to terrace – need to know, want continued discussion re: fence &/or landscaping, return for wall application with further info as it develops. Drop-box color: graphite, bollard needs a black cover, modify log on box, follow-up with a landscape plan, RC motion to approve graphite box-small logo on only 1 side, curbing & paving; landscape plan to follow, LM 2nd, vote: unanimous. MG returns
- 8:20P <u>99 Main Street: TOG-Library</u>: application for a Certificate of Appropriateness to repair a retaining wall along the side of the library building, Library Trustee presenting, *votes may be taken. See above*
- 8:30P <u>Main Street-Rt.119: Lawrence Academy-new entrance</u>: application for a Certificate of Appropriateness for a new curb cut, fieldstone retaining walls with signage, a granite post/wood rail fence & new post style lanterns for the proposed new main campus entrance; Linda Deasy present, votes may be taken. LM recused & left meeting at 9:05P, will email civil engineering & wall details, prefer no sloped granite, will submit lighting, set for public hearing in Jan.
- 8:45P Main Street-Powderhouse Rd: Lawrence Academy-Lawrence House Dormitory: application for a Certificate of Appropriateness to reconfigure the existing sloped shed roof garage addition at the rear of the structure to a new sloped hip-roof to harmonize with the original house; a continuance of the hip-roof addition at the East side of the house; 2 new attic dormers to be added to the North & South side of the existing house: the project will reflect the existing massing, scale, character & details of the original structure, Linda Deasy present, votes may be taken.
