The Meeting was called to order at 7:03 PM.

- 1. The first order of business was: Review minutes and action items from the April meeting
  - Minutes:

      - 3. The motion passed unanimously by roll call vote
  - Action Items:

  - a. Olin Lathrop: NRWA invited representatives from regional communities. Chris Pollitan presented how he maps and prioritizes treatments. Uses a grid of about 200 ft intervals to survey new areas. Discussion after the meeting, -Groton was one of three communities with Invasive Species Committee. Only committee with certified herbicide applicators and mapping program. Talk of arranging a state-wide conference on Invasive Species.
- 7. Olin Lathrop to find contact for Webbers to get permission to treat Ailanthus on Gibbet Hill left messages at Gibbet Hill and the Barn, but has not heard back.
- 8. Olin Lathrop will respond to University of Massachusetts professor Bethany Bradley researcher (that contacted Jonathan Basch) regarding invasive species methods/treatments Olin Lathrop completed the response to the survey
