I am writing to express my strong support for UMass Memorial Health's establishment of the Nashoba Satellite Emergency Facility (SEF) in Groton, MA. This project represents a crucial step toward reinstating dedicated emergency medical services in the Nashoba Valley region, which has become a healthcare desert following the abrupt closure of the Nashoba Valley Medical Center in August 2024.

The absence of local emergency health services since this closure has placed significant burdens on our community, especially impacting our local emergency medical service personnel, fire, and police departments. The necessity for patients to be transported over longer distances to receive life-saving care has not only exacerbated response times but has also strained the resources - both human and financial - of our emergency service providers.
