

# Ad Hoc Committee on Groton Polling Places

Minutes of Meeting – 3 February 2014 – Town Hall Second Floor Lunchroom

Minutes of the 27 January meeting were unanimously approved.

The discussion centered on the use of the Groton Pool and Golf Center, as Town Hall and Prescott School, the other two remaining sites, are largely known quantities.

It was decided to invite GP&GC Manager Bob Whalen and Building Commissioner Ed Cataldo to our next meeting on 10 February to discuss the possibility of providing full access to the building, including parking, and whether this could be accomplished in time for the May Town elections or for the fall elections – particularly the Gubernatorial election in November.


Three scenarios were mentioned:

- 1) Resolve the access and parking problems by the May elections and use the GP&GC for Precincts 2 & 3.
- 2) Use the GP&GC without access improvements for the May election, possibly for only one Precinct, with the other Precinct voting at Town Hall or Prescott School.
- 3) Use Prescott School (and/or Town Hall?) for the May election and work toward using the GP&GC for the fall elections.
