<u>Jamie</u> Metal (fee) Corrugated cardboard - No Styrofoam

- No paperboard

Fluorescent bulbs

Jamie Antifreeze – not mixed with anything but possibly water Batteries, car, any not leaking lead acid batteries Batteries rechargeable & button Motor oil, not mixed with anything else

<u>Nancy</u> Glass Bottles & Jars: Empty, remove lid Mixed Paper, Newspaper, no wrapping paper, staples, & binders OK Cans, Aluminum, Steel, & Tin, Empty

<u>Tessa</u> Plastic containers 1-7, Empty

<u>Diana</u> Books & videos Clothing, Linens, Shoes: OK=stuffed animals, if buttons & zippers broken, Not musty, wet or containing hazardous waste Bulky Plastic, remove large pieces of metal Furniture, Construction Debris (fees-pay at office 1st)
