Black Earth made an offer to manage food waste collection for the town and combine it with the current yard waste. The Town of Ayer currently has Black Earth Pick up food waste from their transfer station and have had a good experience. Tom is exploring the details and would like to offer food waste collection for the town. MassDEP estimates that organics represents more than 25% of the waste stream in Massachusetts after recycling, food materials, compostable paper and other organics are the largest fraction of the remaining waste. So diversion would save the town money and make better compost with the addition of food to yard waste.
