Minutes from the prior meeting on 03-12-2026 were unanimously approved.

Brian Callahan discussed the approval process of the procurement requirement document pertaining to the MA DEP Grant with the Town of Groton. The committee reviewed the document which discusses reducing waste, purchasing recyclable materials etc. Accepted and approved by Brian Callahan and awaiting signature by the town manager.

The committee discussed best practices for the upcoming and new addition Swap Shed to the Transfer Station. There are basic guidelines that need to be set before it is open to the public. Construction to begin in June.

Cooking Oil for recycling, Black Earth can accept small quantities and will process it with other recyclable materials. All cooking oil must be in tightly sealed containers. See transfer station staff if you have questions.
