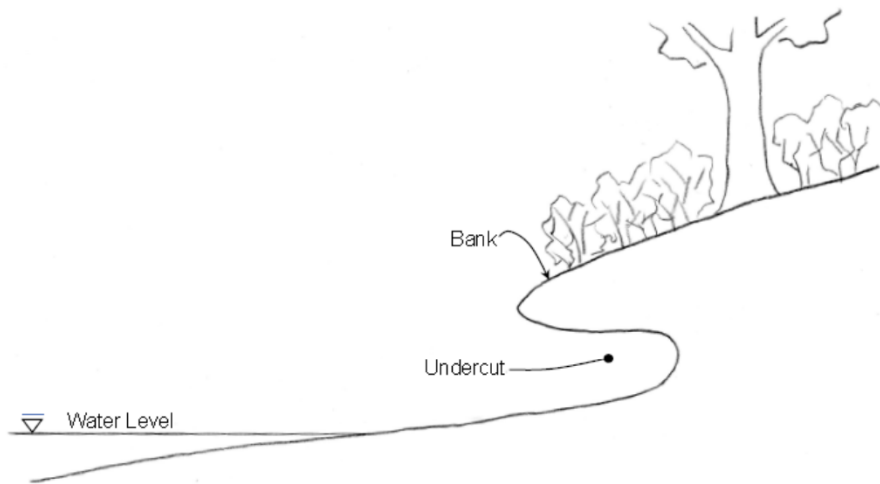






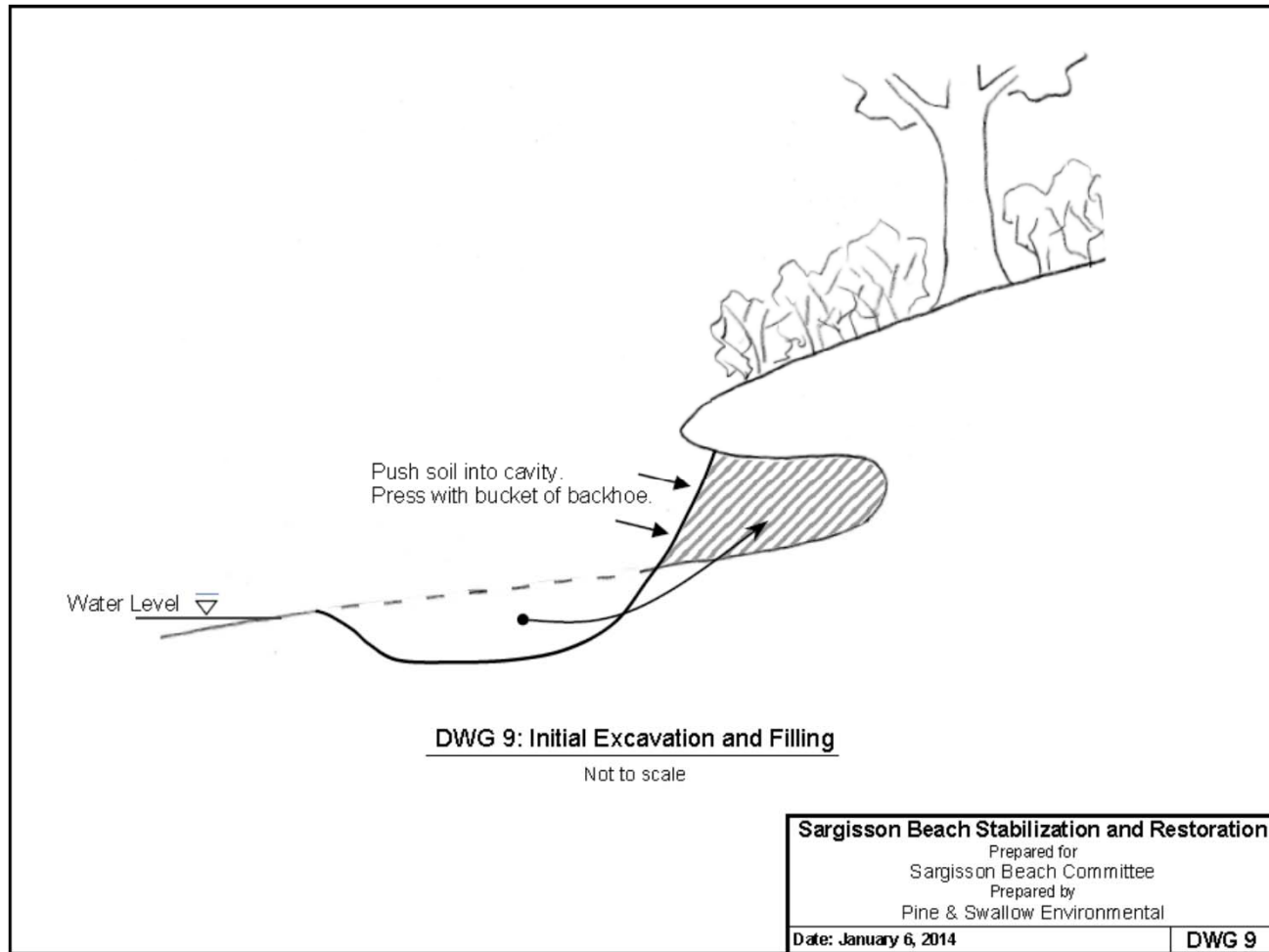

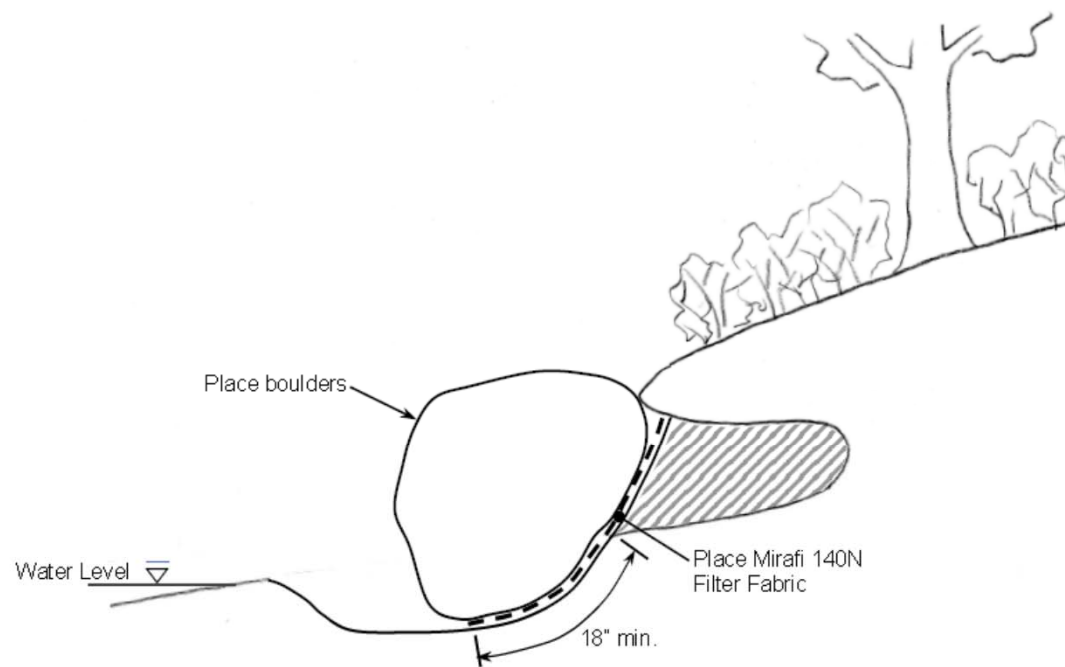




DWG 8: Existing Condition

DWG 10: Placement of Filter Fabric and Boulders

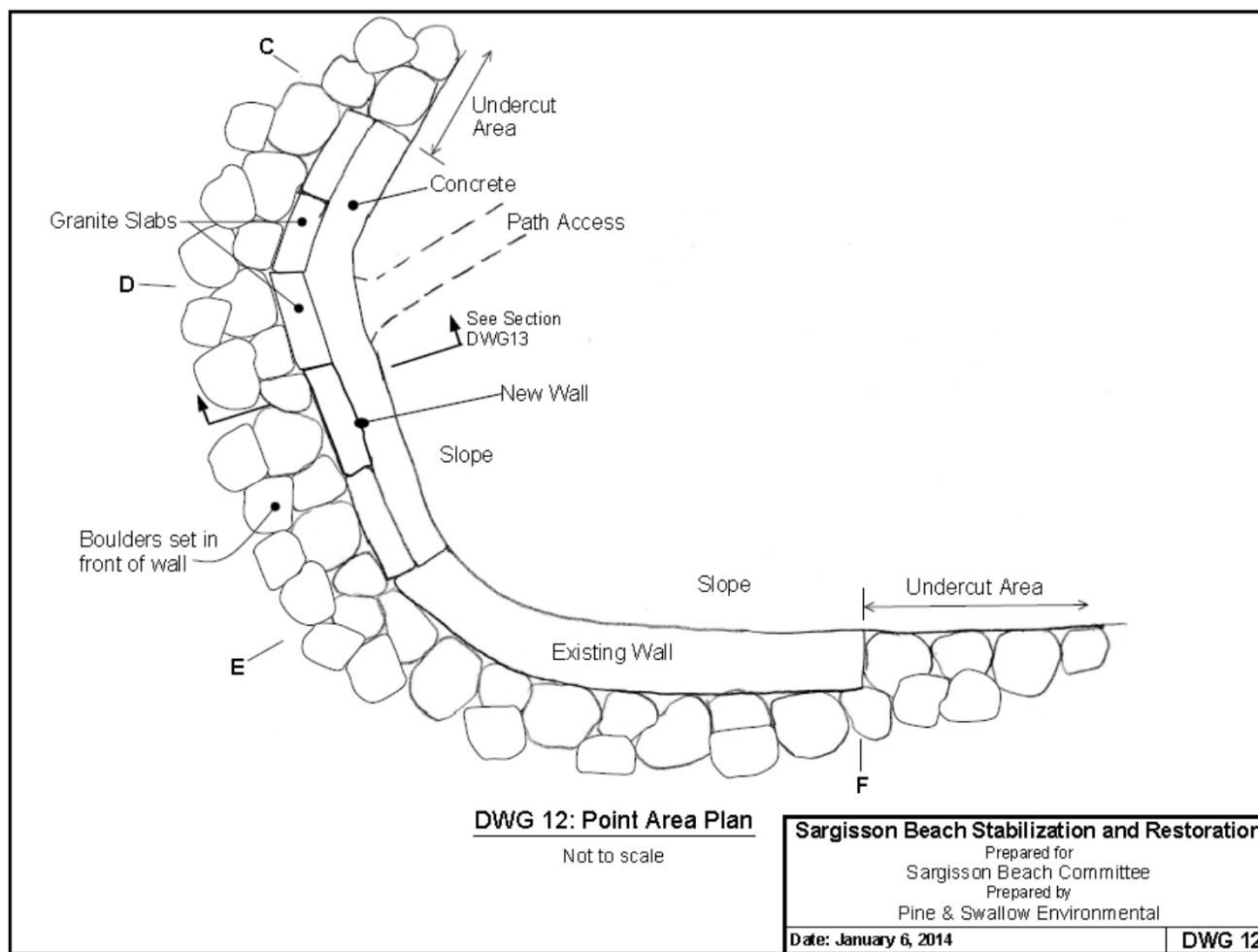

Proposed Reclamation Project

- ❑ Two Phases
 - ❑ Phase 1, Fall 2014 - Embankment Preservation
 - ❑ Phase 2, Fall 2015 – Beach Repair and Revitalization
- ❑ Estimated Total Cost: \$170,500 or less

Proposed Reclamation Project, Phase 1 - Schedule

- ❑ When: Fall 2014
- ❑ Duration: Mid-October through Mid-December (Weather Cooperating)
- ❑ Contingency: Early Spring, 2015, if weather prevents completion in 2014
